Dennis Lee Alvestad, 74, of Ankeny passed away February 27, 2024 at Israel Family Hospice House in Ames. Funeral services will be Saturday March 23rd at 11:00 am at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Story City. Burial will follow in the Roland Cemetery.
