Audrey J. Gauley, 95, passed away peacefully on May 3, 2017.

Audrey was born on August 27, 1921 in Jewell, Iowa to Raymond Thomas and Barbara (Horner) Hood. She lived in Dayton Beach, Florida from age one to fifteen and returned to Jewell in 1936.
