

## Jack Waldo Frandsen

May 24, 1928 - March 23, 2022

Jack Waldo Frandsen 93, died the morning of March 23, 2022. A gathering of friends and family will be held at Soderstrum Funeral Home in Story City on Sunday, March 27th from 3-5 pm. A memorial service will be held at Bergen Lutheran Church in Roland on March 28th at 10:30 am with a military burial service to follow at the Roland Cemetery.

Jack was born May 24th, 1928 - the oldest son of Bill and Almina (Jacobson) Frandsen of rural Story City, Iowa. At six years of age his family moved to their new farm south and west of Roland where Jack lived the rest of his life. Graduating from Roland High School in 1946, he enrolled at Iowa State University where he met his future wife, Dorothy Lehman. They wed in 1950 with plans to farm with his father. However the Korean conflict arose and Jack was drafted. From 1951-53 he served in the Army; 25th Infantry Division, 69th Field Artillery Battalion. He resumed farming until he retired in 1990.

Jack and Dorothy's family grew to five with the births of Ronald Dean, Barbara Jean and Kay Louise. After Dorothy's death, Jack married Lavonne (Winter) Frandson in 1986.

Jack's later years were filled with volunteer work for his church and community; establishing a new subdivision for the town of Roland; stained-glass works and woodworking.

Jack was preceded in death by his three siblings: Paul, Wallace and Zona Gail.

Jack's family includes his wife Lavonne of 33 years; her children: Kathy and Bill Bullock, John and Lynne Frandson and Steve Frandson; Five grandchildren: Tera, Toni, Garret, Brenna and Kristen.

Jack's children: Ronald and Beth; Barbara and Kay; Four grandchildren: Bryan Ness and Natalie Sweeney, Lauren and Alyssa Frandsen.

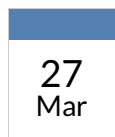

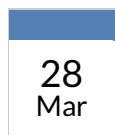
