Darrel G. Larson was born October 3, 1925 to Sherman and Velma (Doolittle) Larson in rural Roland, Iowa. He graduated from Roland High School and served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He married Charlotte Borwick on December 14, 1947. She died May 2, 1995. He then married Dorothy Goodmanson Strum on February 14, 1998. She died March 2, 2013. Darrel was a lifelong farmer in the Roland area. He enjoyed fishing, playing cards and watching television.
