Gregory Thompson, 71, a lifelong resident of Nevada, Iowa passed away in his home of cardiac arrest on July 29, 2024. He was born in Nevada, IA to Harlan and Imogene (Halsted) Thompson where he grew up and graduated from Nevada High School in 1972. He spent his adult life working for Ames Computer Forms.

Greg loved gardening, riding his bicycle, driving on country roads and attending the lowa State Fair. In recent weeks he enjoyed the 4th of July festivities in his hometown. He also attended the Story County Fair every day to see the 4-H exhibits and livestock as he had done for many years.

Our brother was preceded in death by his parents and younger brother, Winton Thompson.
