

Trevor Jason Soderstrum May 18, 1969 - August 25, 2024

Trevor Jason Soderstrum, 55, of Story City passed away on August 25, 2024 at Bethany Life in Story City. Funeral services will be held on Friday, August 30, 2024 at 10:30 A.M. at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Story City. Burial will follow in the Roland Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at the church.

Trevor was born on May 18, 1969 in Story City, Iowa to Dennis and Karen (Holland) Soderstrum. He was baptized at St. Petri Lutheran Church and confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church. He graduated from Roland-Story High School, Simpson College and then with a Master's Degree from Emory University in Atlanta, GA. Trevor preached at Mackey United Methodist Church for 10 years. He used his creative skills to write essays and movie reviews for Toons and later had a column with the Story City Herald, Ames Tribune and Tri-County Times.

Trevor loved his dogs and enjoyed wrestling at the State Wrestling Tournament his Junior and Senior years.

He is survived by his parents, Dennis and Karen Soderstrum of Story City; his three brothers, Brent (Liz) of Alexandria, VA, Matt (Stacy) of Story City and Marc (Michelle) of Roland; his sister Shauna of Johnston; 13 nieces and nephews and 11 great nieces and nephews.
