

Loren D. Twedt February 17, 1932 - October 07, 2022

Loren D. Twedt, 90, of Story City passed away October 7, 2022 at Mary Greeley Medical Center. Funeral services will be Thursday October 13th at 10:30 a.m. at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Story City. Burial will follow in the Roland Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Immanuel Lutheran Church.

Loren was born on a farm north of Roland on February 17, 1932 to Orville and Odell (Larson) Twedt. He graduated from Roland High School in 1950 and was drafted into the U.S. Army; serving in Texas and Korea. Loren married Solvay Stole on June 5, 1955. He and Solvay lived south of Roland, where Loren farmed for many years. Loren was a member of Bergen Lutheran Church; serving on the Church Council and head usher. He then joined Immanuel Lutheran Church, where he served on the Church Council and served as an usher.

Loren served on the Roland-Story School Board for 15 years and about that time, he served on the Federal Land Bank Board for 15 years. One of Loren's greatest joys were restoring his 1928 Model A and John Deere A tractor. He also enjoyed golfing and playing baseball and softball.

Loren is survived by his wife, Solvay of Story City; his daughter, Sandy Larson of Ankeny; two sons, Jeff (Lynne) of Roland and Chris of Ankeny; six grandchildren, Nick, Justin, Ryan, Jared, Kamron and Ajay; and a brother, Duke Twedt of Dallas, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his son Bradley and a brother, Anley.
