

## Rosemary A. Sampson

January 21, 1929 - December 24, 2013

Rosemary Ann Fausch was born on January 21, 1929 at Lutheran Hospital in Des Moines, lowa, to Elida Reinertson Fausch and Arthur J. Fausch. She attended Kelley Community School, North Grant School and graduated as Valedictorian from Roland High School in 1946. She married Robert E. Sampson on October 22, 1949 at Bergen Lutheran Church in Roland, Iowa. Bob and Rosemary farmed in the Roland, Gilbert and Madrid areas until Bob's retirement in 1982. They lived the rest of their lives in Ames.
